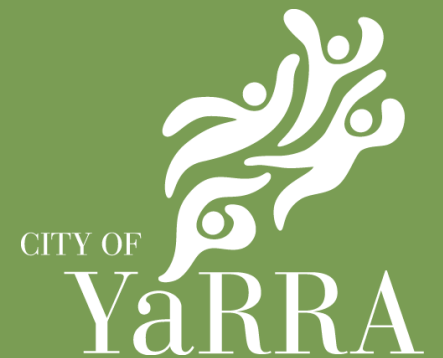

Action 3 Increase space for pedestrians and bikes, dedicated lanes/corridors (on commercial/retail streets?) and decrease car space on the streets

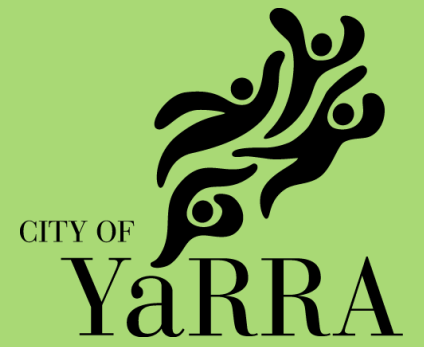
Action 4 Require better bicycle parking as part of major commercial and residential?


