


#### **Improving Nutrition Governance**

## A Food & Nutrition Action Plan for Surabaya City Government

Probability-weighted impact of policies on undernourishment, based on food insecurity risks




- Domestic agricultural production and food & nutrition security are economically and politically important in Indonesia.
- A significant focus of Indonesia's food & nutrition security program (amounting to around USD 2 billion per year) is on rice.
- Reducing undernourishment remain a policy priority, but Indonesia's current food & nutrition security strategies are not the best way to achieve this goal.

#### National Challenges

### Urban Challenges

- Indonesia's current food & nutrition security strategy doesn't meet urban need
- 56% of 260 million Indonesians were living in urban area in 2015, and this figure will rise to 67% in 2035
- The prevalence of obesity of Indonesian urban areas is 20% -53% higher than in rural areas
- Food and nutrition system is not in priority of urban development policy in Indonesia

- Working with the Surabaya city government to improve the urban governance for nutritious and safe food (NSF) systems, through:
  - develop the city action plan to improve access and demand to Nutritious and Safe Food;
  - identify possible interventions that can be led and funded by the city government and identify potential actors that can collaborate on the implementation, specifically private sector;
  - work with media to develop mechanisms to create transparancy and accountability on the plan and its implementation
  - provide TA to implement key interventions.
